She has started a non-profit organization called Moms on a Mission. Read below to see how Desiree is impacting her community and what Moms on a Mission is all about.

Moms on a Mission: We are a group of local women who donate laundry baskets full of household items to families moving out of homeless shelters into permanent housing.

It all started with a girl's night out and a desire to teach our children to value others, appreciate what they have and give back to the community. This led us to brainstorm how we can

do this on an ongoing basis, not only Christmas and holidays.

Most families leaving a shelter have nothing to bring with them, not even a blanket, so this would be their jump start until they get on their feet.

Start small, leave a lasting impact.

Since April 2018 - we've already donated over 10 pack n plays, 10 mothers day pamper gifts, 10 Easter baskets, 20 Christmas bags, 20 shelter kits, 28 first day of school outfits, and over 100 fully packed baskets for families moving out!
